§2(4) p.2 German Higher Education Framework Act

Higher education institutions ensure that students with disabilities are not disadvantaged in their studies and can use their university's services as independently as possible.

§16 p.3 German Higher Education Framework Act
Examination regulations must take into account the special needs of students with disabilities in order to ensure equal opportunities.

§13 (2) p.2 General examination regulations for Bachelor and Master programmes at Ernst Abbe University of Applied Sciences Jena:

As part of an assessment of academic achievement, there is an obligation to compensate for disadvantages that a person being tested may have compared to other test takers, in particular any disadvantages resulting from disability and chronic illness.

You have the right to compensation for disadvantages.
